PRISM is a doctoral programme led by **Université PSL in Paris**, dedicated to training a new generation of scientists and innovators capable of addressing today's **environmental challenges**. In response to global warming, plastic pollution, resource scarcity and biodiversity loss, PRISM develops an interdisciplinary approach combining **physics, chemistry, biology and engineering** to design disruptive technologies for the environmental transition.

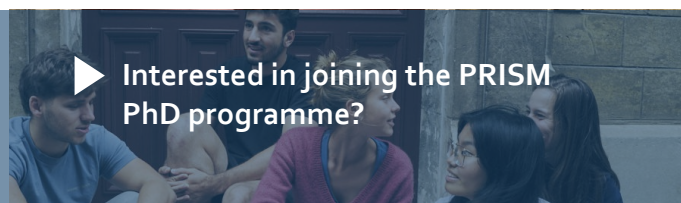
